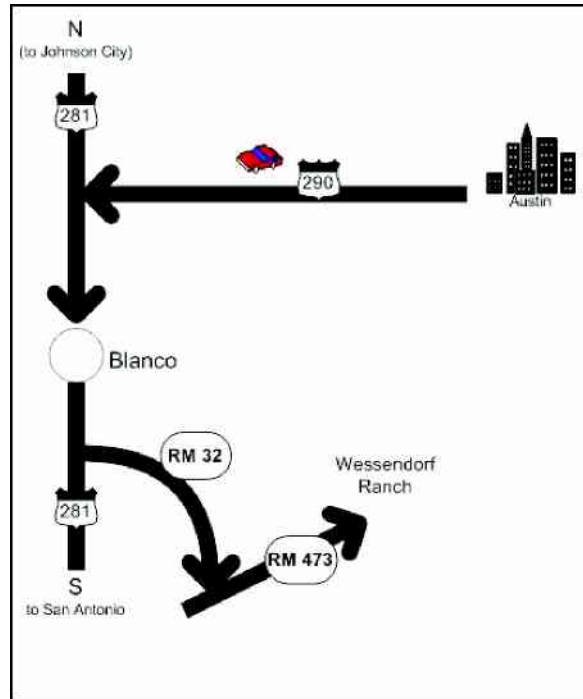
Registration fee is \$70, payable to St. Matthew's Episcopal Church.

Go 6 miles to the junction of RR 473 and turn left onto Narrows Road, which is 473. Then follow the signs to the Well Springs Retreat Center at Wessendorf Ranch.
